

Retiree Exelon Allsup Questionnaire

All pre-65 retirees, who are covered on the Exelon Medical Plan, are receiving an Exelon Allsup questionnaire mailing to determine if they have become 'disabled', and or will be collecting Social Security Disability benefits presently or in the future. If this is the case, you normally can collect Social Security Disability Benefits for 2 years and then you must enroll in Medicare. If this occurs, Exelon has 2 plans to supplement Medicare until you reach age 65. If you fail to enroll in Medicare when you are required to do so, there is an approximate 10% per year Medicare Part B premium penalty added to the regular premium. Exelon sends these questionnaires out every 3 years to ensure you do not fall into this Medicare situation.
